



VOTING INTENTIONS POLL

Published 3rd May 2011

A poll was conducted by TNS–BMRB to establish current voting intentions in Scotland in relation to the constituency and regional votes for the upcoming election to the Scottish Parliament.

The results of this poll were published by stv on 3rd May 2011.

TNS-BMRB is a member of the British Polling Council (BPC) and abides by its rules. We also operate within the Code of Conduct of the Market Research Society (MRS). In accordance with these rules the following information is provided:

Interview method	Face-to-face, in-home, self completion
Population sampled	All adults aged 18+ in Scotland
Sampling method	The poll was conducted through our Omnibus, Scottish Opinion Survey. For this survey, sampling points are selected to be representative of Scotland demographically and geographically. Within each sampling point, a quota sampling method is used for respondent selection.
Data weighting	Data is weighted to the profile of all adults aged 18+ in Scotland, based on population profile estimates from the BARB (Broadcasters' Audience Research Board) Establishment Survey 2 Years Ending December 2008 and the 2001 Census. Weighting is carried out in relation to working status within gender, age, social grade and electoral region. Additional weighting was applied based on past voting behaviour at the Scottish parliament election in 2007 (constituency vote). Unweighted and weighted bases are shown at the top of each data table.
Voting intentions	Two tables are supplied for each measure of voting intentions. The first of these is based on all respondents and shows the percentages 'uncommitted' – i.e. who were either undecided, refused to say how they might vote or said that they would not vote at all. The second table excludes this 'uncommitted' group and re-percentages party support based on all those naming a party. It is these latter figures which are published as the measure of voting intentions. Results are shown for both the constituency and regional votes for Holyrood. Data tables also show the results for those who stated they were 'certain to vote' at the election as a crossbreak.
